### CRIME OF THE WEEK

- All staff attended a training session on active shooter incidents. This training was set up so that all law enforcement use the same tactics when dealing with an active shooter incident. The Fort Morgan Police Department, Colorado State Patrol, Morgan County Sheriff's Office, Wiggins Police Department and Log Lane Police Department all participated.
