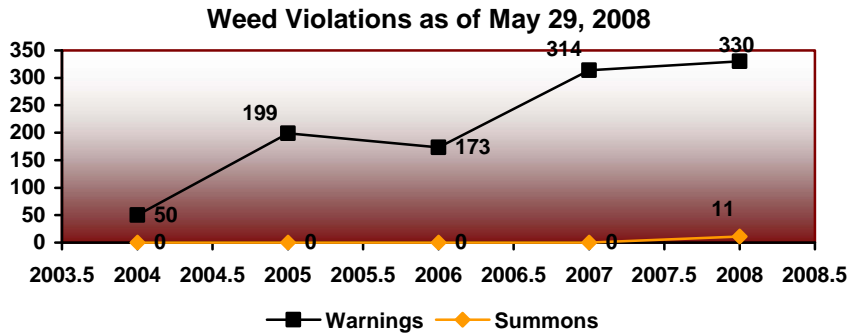

**ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS**

The Fort Morgan Police Department has been working diligently toward the beautification of Fort Morgan. Officers of the Department have teamed with Code Enforcement Officers to monitor weed ordinance compliance. As of May 29, 2008, the department has issued 330 warnings for weed violations and 11 summonses. Below is a comparison of warnings and summons issued as of this date from 2004 through 2008. We have been concentrating on educating the public about the violations and enforcing repeat violations.
