CRIMES OF THE WEEK

Between March 1 and March 6, 2008, there were three incidents of vandalism to two residences and on elementary school. The residences at 201 and 213 Gateway Avenue each had "SUR 13" spray painted on the outside of the residences. This is a common "tagging" for the Sureno 13 gang. One of the residences also had a broken window.

On March 6, 2008, Green Acres School was burglarized and had graffiti spray painted on the interior walls. The graffiti consisted of a Nazi Swastika, "teck", "kawz", "MS13", and "Mota.
