### CRIME OF THE WEEK

On May 14 at about 1:00 p.m., a 57 year old Fort Morgan man was the victim of a first degree assault and aggravated robbery. The incident occurred behind the Safeway Store at 620 West Platte Avenue. The assault occurred when two young Hispanic males attempted to take a bicycle from the victim while he was sitting down resting. During the altercation, one of the suspects picked up a piece of wood and struck the victim in the back of the head causing serious bodily injury. It is believed the suspects fled on foot running in a southwest direction.
